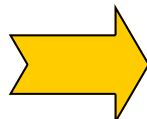
### BL6 Academic Concern

- Non-attendance to appraisal meeting
- Conduct out of lessons



### Academic concern—Form Tutor is notified, Subject Teacher support before Head of Department support

1. Verbal warning/Moved places
2. Teacher sets targets in subject progress meeting with review date
3. Contact parents/guardian by telephone. Referral to Head of Department
4. Compulsory attendance to subject and revision clinics
5. Formalised targets from subject teacher and agreed by HOD/HOCR

### Non-academic concern—Form Tutor intervention

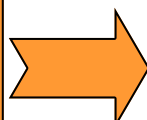
1. Verbal warning in person or via email/phone
2. Target set with review date during a progress meeting. Parent/guardian contacted by telephone/letter/email.

### Head of Curriculum Area response for repeated academic concerns, Progress Tutor is notified, Progress Manager support

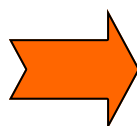
1. Verbal warning in person
